## COVID-19 Patient Care and Infection Prevention & Control (IPC) Measures

## **Orange Phase: Patient/Designated Visitor Personal Items**

- The current restrictions regarding Patient and/or designated visitor personal items remain in place with the following exceptions re: clothing. Please see <u>Bulletin 21b</u>, <u>April 9, 2020</u>
- "New" Patient clothing will now be allowed to be brought in for hospital inpatients.
- "New" Units/departments that have a "donation" box of clothing, or have a clothing depot service available, can replenish their stock using the above criteria.
- All items, including clothing must meet the following criteria before being accepted:
  - Person delivering clothing must pass the screening process questions:
    - Are these items coming from a household with any occupant currently under direction to self-isolate?
       AND
    - Are these Items packaged in a manner that enables them to be easily cleaned and disinfected?
  - Clothing must be freshly laundered and placed in a plastic bag or container that can be easily cleaned and disinfected.
- The current process to deliver these personal items will remain in place.

## Orange Phase: Food brought in facilities from/for healthcare workers

The established process for food brought in facilities from/for healthcare workers will remain in place (as published in <u>Bulletin 21b</u>, <u>April 9</u>, <u>2020</u>).
