

Getting to work safely:

Have a plan in place for getting to work safely when severe weather hits. Here is where you can find <u>storm safety</u> <u>information</u> for you and your family as well as current forecasts, alerts, public advisories and road conditions.

Keeping patients informed: Report delays in service, cancellations, or closures

Managers are reminded to send information on any storm cancellations, closures, or significant changes in service to <u>Cancellations</u>. This important information for patients is posted on Horizon's website and on our social media channels.

COVID-19 Bulletin directory

Improvements have been made to the way Bulletins and Summary Bulletins are stored on Skyline to help staff easily access all COVID-19 related memos and information.

A new <u>COVID-19 Bulletin Directory</u> is now live on Skyline's Coronavirus Resources page.

The directory makes it easy to find specific Bulletin memos and summaries.

In the "Find a file" search bar, type in key words related to the information you're looking for, and all related bulletin memos will appear, with the most recent memos appearing at the top of your search.

The "Circulated On" drop down tab allows you to search bulletins by date.

If you want to see only Summary Bulletins, search "Summary Bulletin" and all summary bulletins will be listed, starting with most recent.

Self screening reminder


We want to remind all employees and physicians of the importance of remaining familiar with the screening questions.

The questions and signage for employees and physicians can be accessed <u>here</u>. All updated posters are available on the <u>Coronavirus Skyline page</u>.

Remember:

- Employees and physicians are required to self-screen prior to leaving home for their shift.
- Once at the facility, employees and physicians must swipe their ID badge, and confirm to a screener that they have completed their self-assessment prior to each entry, and that they have not answered "yes" to any of the questions.









- Employees and physicians who leave the facility for any reason (break, meal period, to smoke, or interfacility travel) will be required to be actively re-screened upon their return.
- To ensure that you arrive on time in your unit / department, we ask that you factor potential delays into the travel plans.

Employee Health is available daily from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. to answer any questions or concerns – please call 1-833-978-2580 and leave a voicemail and your call will returned within two hours.
