As part of the Government of New Brunswick's COVID-19 vaccine strategy, vaccines arriving in the province are being used to protect the most vulnerable and maintain the continuity of health care services.

Today, we are pleased to share, thanks to the tremendous work of our teams running our health care worker vaccination clinics, all Horizon employees in the initial priority group (health care workers and allied health care professionals providing direct patient care) have received an invitation to attend an upcoming vaccination clinic.

Now, we are ready to offer vaccines to health care workers with indirect patient care **responsibilities.** This means all Horizon employees could soon be offered the opportunity to receive their first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. Second dose appointment invitations will come at a later date.

Our health care worker vaccination clinics will remain by **invitation-only**, and **appointments will be provided on a first-come, first served basis.**

Employees in some areas may receive an invitation to a clinic in their area as early as today, for a weekend appointment. Invitations will be sent to Horizon email with all information necessary to book an appointment, including a consent form that will need to be completed, printed and brought to the vaccination appointment.
