

### **COVID-19 Bulletin**



#### **GNB** vaccination policy for employees

As demonstrated by the current cluster of COVID-19 cases in the Moncton region where 94 per cent of the cases are not fully vaccinated, vaccination is the single most effective way to prevent the spread of the virus and to protect ourselves individually and collectively, especially our children.

As the provider of public services, we must take the steps needed to ensure a safe and healthy environment for our employees as well as all citizens who access our services.

Cabinet has approved a policy that requires GNB employees:

- to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19; or
- if they do not provide proof of full vaccination, to wear a mask in the workplace and undergo regular testing for COVID-19 until they are fully vaccinated.

## Please note: Masks will continue to be mandatory for all Horizon staff, physicians and volunteers.

The policy also makes full vaccination against COVID-19 a condition of employment for newly hired employees (except for those who provide a medical certificate of their exemption from the vaccine).

The effective date for this new policy will be communicated once we confirm, in consultation with Public Health, the details for:

- medical exemptions;
- the testing requirements (e.g. frequency and type of testing) and process;
- the process for providing proof of vaccination.

These details will be communicated very soon. In the meantime, you are encouraged to get vaccinated if you have not done so already.
