

Travel Guidelines for Health Care Workers

Atlantic Provinces*	 Self monitor** Perform POCT 3 times/week for 14 days post return to NB 	 Remain out of the workplace for 14 days following return to NB. PCR Swab Day 10
Outside of the Atlantic Provinces	 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Swab Day 5 upon return to NB Continue to work & self monitor** 	 Remain out of the workplace for 14 days following return to NB. PCR Swab Day 10
Outside of Canada	 PCR Swabs Day 1 must be completed on Canadian Soil. PCR Swabs Day 5 and 10 upon return to NB. Work isolate until results of Day 5 swab obtained and negative Self monitor** 	 Remain out of the workplace for 14 days following return to NB. PCR Swab Day 10

^{*}Atlantic Provinces (NB, NS, PEI, NFLD) or the Avignon and Témiscouata Regional Counties and Listuguj First Nation in Quebec – no restrictions

Please note <u>all</u> travel outside of New Brunswick requires pre-travel registration through the GNB website regardless of vaccination status

Outside of the Atlantic Provinces:

- Follow all NB travel guidelines at <u>New Brunswick</u> travel registration
- Submit travel notification form & agree to testing upon return to NB on Day 5
- Health care workers are responsible to book their own PCR swab <u>COVID-19 Testing and Tracing (gnb.ca)</u>

Outside of Canada:

- Follow all Provincial and Federal travel registration apply for New Brunswick travel registration & ArriveCan travel registration
- Submit travel notification form & agree to testing upon return to the workplace with notification to Employee Health if positive PCR swab results
- Follow Work Isolation guidelines until Day 5 results available and negative
- Health care workers are responsible to book their own PCR swabs <u>COVID-19 Testing and Tracing (gnb.ca)</u>

Undue Hardship/Exceptional Circumstance:

Please contact Regional Manager of Employee Health & Wellness if there is an exceptional circumstance that is causing undue hardship, such as and
not limited to; shared custody, receiving medical care in US, primary care provider for US resident. may qualify for an exception to the above listed
guidelines. Note: Each situation will be reviewed and decided upon on a case by case basis and an individual plan including testing will be developed
