Horizon IPC Guidance: Continuous Use of N95 Respirators/Medical Grade Face Masks and **Eye Protection for Full Shifts in Healthcare Settings During COVID-19 Pandemic - All Phases**

The IPC guidance documents have been updated to reflect the Revised COVID-19 Enhanced Precautionary Guidance for Use of Personal Protective Equipment document issued by the province of New Brunswick on Jan. 11, 2022.

The documents support that a well fitted medical grade face mask remains an appropriate level of PPE for the care of a suspect / confirmed COVID-19 patient, however as a precautionary measure the guidance puts forth recommendations regarding the use of N95 respirators.

The IPC Guidance: Continuous Use of N95 Respirators/Medical Grade Face Masks and Eye Protection for Full Shifts in Healthcare Settings During COVID-19 Pandemic has been updated to reflect the following additional information:

- A definition for "well-fitted medical grade face mask"
- The requirement for the continuous use of eye protection in clinical and non-clinical settings in IPC Red Phase
- The addition of a process for:
 - Continuous use of N95 respirators as a PPE conventional strategy
 - Extended Use of N95 respirators as a PPE Contingency Strategy
 - Limited reuse of a N95 Respirators as a PPE Crisis Strategy

















Revised: Horizon IPC Guidance: Aerosol Generating Medical Procedures (AGMPs) During **COVID-19 Pandemic**

The Horizon IPC Guidance document for AGMPs During COVID-19 Pandemic was revised to reflect the Provincial Guidance document.

High Risk AGMPs now includes:

- Nasopharyngeal endoscopy/procedures with irrigation or high-pressure suction Moderate to Unknown Risk AGMPs
 - Nasopharyngoscopy/laryngoscopy
