New: IPC Guidance - Inpatient Leave of Absence - Red Phase

The ID-IPC COVID-19 Committee has developed a process to facilitate Leave of Absence (LOA) during the Red Phase as part of the care plan determined by the health care team. The following are key highlights contained within the document.

- Inpatient movement will remain restricted during the Red Phase. This includes smoking passes and patient movement off the inpatient unit. Exceptions include the use of dedicated outdoor spaces and patient passes/leave of absences.
- Revisions were made to reflect Public Health measures for vulnerable patients or patients at risk for severe illness such as physical distancing, use of face masks and hand hygiene will be followed by the patient and all members of the household.
- A sentinel testing strategy was added for patients returning from overnight or day passes/leave of absences.
- Patient passes/leave of absences may be authorized by an Administrative Director or their designate.

Revised: IPC Guidance - Sexual Assault Response Team - COVID-19 Pandemic - All Phases

The ID-IPC COVID-19 Committee has revised the Sexual Assault Response Team Volunteer Guidelines to reflect the amended vaccination policy and to permit these volunteers to be on site to provide support to individuals who present to the Emergency Department for sexual assault related incidents during all phases of the pandemic.

Revised: Staff Instructions for Discharging COVID-19 Patients from Acute Care Facility - All Phases

The discharge instructions for COVID-19 positive patients was revised to clarify Public Health reporting requirements. Prior to the discharge of a COVID-19 positive patient to a vulnerable setting (Long Term Care, Homeless Shelters, Correctional and Adult Residential Facilities), the care team will provide relevant information on the care of the patient to the community-based care provider.
