GNB Updates

Public Health reported no new cases of COVID-19 on Wednesday, April 14.

The number of confirmed cases in New Brunswick is 118 and the number of active cases is 14. To date, 104 people have recovered.

There are five patients hospitalized, including one patient in an intensive care unit.

Dr. Jennifer Russell, chief medical officer of health, said the test results continue to be encouraging, but she urged New Brunswickers to practise physical distancing when they go out.

Continued adherence to these practices will help prevent the re-emergence of the virus, she said.
