Importance of self-screening for employees and physicians

As we work together through the COVID-19 pandemic, it is important to be reminded of what's expected of everyone before entering any Horizon facility.

Every employee and physician must review the screening criteria to determine whether they may enter, or whether additional contact and follow-up with Employee Health and Wellness is required.

All employees and physicians are reminded that they must self-screen, **clean their hands**, and follow protocols related to appropriate physical distancing and wearing of procedural masks in all Horizon facilities. The Infection Prevention and Control Guidance: Workforce

Development Educational Delivery was developed to promote
the organizational mandate of maintaining educational
competencies and facilitate educational sessions which require

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hands-on demonstration and testing whenever virtual delivery is not feasible during the Yellow Phase.

The document outlines IPC guidance associated with the following components of the educational session delivery:

- COVID-19 Prescreening Requirements
- Processes related to registration the day of the educational session
- Cleaning protocols during and following the educational session

Ongoing and consistent application of IPC measures will be implemented in accordance with the Horizon Clinical Recovery Plan.
