COVID-19 patient care and infection prevention and control (IPC) measures

Isolation requirements for various recovery levels

Inpatients transferred from the Moncton area (Zone 1) while in an Orange phase, to a facility in a Yellow phase **prior** to 12 a.m. (midnight) Oct. 22, 2020, must be kept under droplet / contact precautions until the 14-day isolation period has passed.

Patients who present from the Moncton area for health care services at any Horizon facility, and who pass screening, no longer require isolation precautions due to travel from the Moncton area.

Patients who present to a Horizon facility from the Campbellton area (Zone 5) must be isolated under IPC precautions during their outpatient visit or while hospitalized for 14 days, as the Campbellton area remains in the Orange phase.

Patients who have visited or had contact with a resident or staff member from the Manoir Notre-Dame in Moncton in the past 14 days must be isolated under IPC precautions during their outpatient visit or while hospitalized for 14 days as the Manoir Notre-Dame of Moncton remains under outbreak precautions.
