## <u>Self-screening criteria for employees and physicians</u> <u>entering facilities – Yellow phase</u>

With the return to the Yellow phase of recovery, employees and physicians in the Fredericton (Zone 3) and Moncton (Zone 1) areas must self screen prior to entering any Horizon facility. In the Saint John (Zone 2) area, active screening remains in place while under the Orange level.

Please review the screening questions and remain familiar with them. The questions and signage can be accessed <u>here</u>. All updated posters are available on the <u>Coronavirus Skyline page</u>.

If an employee or physician answers **yes** to any of the questions, they are not to enter the facility. They must contact Employee Health and Wellness (1-833-978-2580) for further screening and possible referral to a COVID-19 assessment centre.
