<u>Call for respiratory therapists to support COVID-19</u> vaccination clinics

Respiratory therapists (RTs) can complete training to become immunizers at our upcoming community COVID-19 vaccination clinics.

In order to efficiently immunize our population, we are building a strong and committed workforce dedicated to COVID-19 vaccination clinics, while also maintaining services in our hospitals and community sites.

The Redeployment Centre is active to redeploy staff affected by a service slow down or closure to an area of high need and to staff those services impacted by an increase in service needs during our pandemic response such as a vaccination clinic.

If you are working part-time or casual and looking to pick up extra shifts to assist in these areas or are working fulltime and affected by a service slow down, please speak to your manager. Your manager can add your name to the redeployment tracker with the number of shifts you are available to help with. We are also recruiting for non-clinical (administrative) positions like screening, registration, wayfinding, recovery, and runners. The process for redeployment is the same as for clinical positions, please talk to your manager.

Updated: Take Out Food and Homemade Food

Take-out and homemade food will now be permitted for patients in all phases of the pandemic.

Take-out food must come from a licensed establishment and will only be permitted if a support person / visitor is available to deliver to the patient's room. Staff will not be responsible for the delivery of food. Food delivery personnel will not be permitted to deliver food to the patient's room.

If a patient chooses to have take-out food delivered at the hospital, the delivery person will need to successfully pass the screening protocol at the facility's designated entrance before

the food is accepted into the facility. The support person / visitor will then pick up the food at the entrance.

Homemade food is permitted if a support person / visitor is available to deliver the food to the patient's room. The food must be stored in a container that can be easily cleaned and disinfected with a hospital approved cleaner / disinfectant wipe. The container must be taken home for cleaning and not left in the patient's room.

This change has been made to the Patient / Designated Visitor Personal Items Table located on <u>Skyline</u>.


GNB updates

Public Health reported three new cases of COVID-19 yesterday (March 3), two cases in Zone 3 (Fredericton region), and one in Zone 7 (Miramichi region).

A mass testing clinic has been set up in Zone 7. This is available for individuals who do not have any symptoms of COVID-19 but want to be tested. Testing will be held over two days:

- Today, March 4, until 7 p.m., at the gymnasium of the Dr. Losier Middle School, 124 Henderson St., Miramichi; and
- Tomorrow, March 5, from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m., at the gymnasium of the Dr. Losier Middle School, 124 Henderson St., Miramichi.









No appointment is necessary. Screening tests will be done on a first-come, first-served basis.
