



## **Visitor Guidelines for Hospitals and Health Care Facilities**

Social visits can occur between 2 and 8 p.m., daily.

## All visitors must:

- Self-monitor for symptoms and follow all Infection Prevention and Control precautions.
- Wear a face mask. When you come to a hospital or health care facility for an appointment or to visit a loved one, you will be asked to put on a face mask before entering.
- Maintain physical distancing and clean hands frequently.
- Only go to the patient's room and limit interactions with staff, patients and other visitors.
