Re: **Current DSP Vaccination Guidelines Remain in Place**

Following consultation with the Infectious Disease and Infection and Prevention Control COVID-19 Committee, and approval from the Horizon Emergency Operations Committee, the current requirement for designated support persons (DSPs) to be fully vaccinated will remain in place.

Persons are *fully vaccinated* if they have received the full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada. New Brunswick accepts any COVID-19 vaccine approved by the Government of Canada administered as per immunization schedule.

Like all New Brunswickers, DSPs are encouraged to keep their COVID-19 vaccines up to date.

DSPs who are not fully vaccinated will complete testing requirements as outlined in the [IPC DSP Vaccination Guidelines](#).
