	Testing and Isolation	Leave Provisions
<p>❖ <b>Up to date</b> vaccine status is defined as 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine plus a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine OR 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine AND not greater than 5 months from second dose.</p> <p>❖ For all occupational exposures and outbreak testing guidelines, please refer to scenario #8 &amp; #9.</p>		
<p><b>Previously COVID-19 Positive Health Care Worker</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NO POCT or PCR required for 90 days post positive PCR test, except for #3 &amp; #4</li> <li>• <b>Note:</b> Testing for scenario #3 &amp; #4 only if greater than 30 days since positive PCR result AND new onset of symptoms. Notify Employee Health.</li> </ul>	
<p>#1: Do you or any family members have <b>ONE</b> symptom?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Continue to work</li> <li>2. HCW should perform POCT test or Abbott ID Now where available. Abbott ID Now is the preferred method for POCT testing while in the workplace and is available at EH on-site testing clinics</li> <li>3. Self-monitor for further symptoms</li> <li>4. If you have fever, loss of taste or smell, follow scenario #3</li> </ol>	<p>Not applicable.</p>
<p>#2: Do you have another member of your household with <b>TWO or more</b> symptoms?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Continue to work</li> <li>2. Self-monitor for symptoms and if possible, isolate from symptomatic family member</li> <li>3. If you develop fever, loss of taste or smell follow #3</li> </ol>	<p>Not applicable.</p>
<p>#3: Do you have <b>ONE</b> of the following symptoms? Fever, loss of taste or smell.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remain out of the workplace and notify manager</li> <li>2. Book self-referral for PCR at <a href="http://GNB.ca">GNB.ca</a> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If PCR negative, and you are symptom free you can return to work.</li> <li>• If PCR positive, follow scenario #5</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. Notify manager of results.</li> </ol>	<p>Sick time can be used to ensure continuity of salary for these absences. If non-inpatient HCW, Manager may offer work from home if the role permits.</p>
<p>#4: Do you have <b>TWO or more</b> symptoms?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remain out of the workplace and notify manager</li> <li>2. Book a self-referral for PCR at <a href="http://GNB.ca">GNB.ca</a> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If PCR negative, return to work when symptoms improve</li> <li>• If PCR positive, follow scenario #5</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. Notify manager of results</li> </ol>	<p>Sick time can be used to ensure continuity of salary for these absences. If non-inpatient HCW, Manager may offer work from home if the role permits.</p>
<p>#5: Do you have a <b>positive POCT or PCR?</b> (Day zero is date of positive POCT or PCR, whichever comes first.)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remain out of the workplace and notify manager</li> <li>2. Notify Employee Health (1-833-978-2580)</li> <li>3. If not confirmed with PCR, book self-referral for PCR at <a href="http://GNB.ca">GNB.ca</a></li> <li>4. If PCR negative, return to work immediately if you have no symptoms or once symptoms improve</li> <li>5. If PCR positive, isolate for 10 days from date of positive POCT or PCR, whichever comes first</li> <li>6. Notify manager of results</li> <li>7. Return to work for immunocompromised HCW will require and assessment for severity of compromise by the HCW primary care provider if no Primary Health care provider available the HCW can contact <a href="http://eVisitNB">eVisitNB</a> for a medical consult. HCW will report severity level to EHS to determine return to work date.</li> </ol>	<p>Sick time can be used to ensure continuity of salary for these absences.  If non-inpatient HCW, Manager may offer work from home if the role permits.</p>

<p>#6: Are you a <b>close contact</b> of a POCT positive or a confirmed PCR positive case <b>in your home</b>?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remain out of the workplace for 10 days following last contact with the positive case</li> <li>2. <a href="#">Work isolate</a> for 10 days after return to work</li> <li>3. Book a PCR test on day 5 and 10 at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a>. You may return to work while waiting for result of day 10</li> <li>4. Abbott ID testing is recommended on day 7. If Abbott ID testing not available obtain POCT from manager and perform testing on day 7.</li> <li>5. Book a PCR at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a> as early as possible if you develop symptoms</li> <li>6. If you have a positive POCT or PCR follow #5</li> </ol>	<p>Applicable leave of absence to be determined on a case by case basis. Leave provisions not applicable for work isolation. If non-inpatient HCW, Manager may offer work from home if the role permits.</p>
<p>#7: Are you a <b>close contact</b> of a POCT positive or a confirmed PCR positive case <b>in the community</b> and can isolate from the positive case?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remain out of the workplace for 5 days following last contact with the positive case</li> <li>2. <a href="#">Work isolate</a> for 5 days after return to work</li> <li>3. Book a PCR test at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a> on day 5 and 10. You may return to work while waiting for results.</li> <li>4. Abbott ID testing is recommended on day 7. If Abbott ID testing not available obtain POCT from manager and perform testing on day 7.</li> <li>5. If you have a positive POCT or PCR follow #5</li> </ol>	<p>Applicable leave of absence to be determined on a case by case basis. Leave provisions not applicable for work isolation. If non-inpatient HCW, Manager may offer work from home if the role permits.</p>

### Occupational Exposure

<p>#8: HCW notified of an <b>occupational exposure</b> to a COVID-19 positive patient or staff member (from 48 hours prior to onset of symptoms or date of POCT/PCR if asymptomatic) <b>Note:</b> not applicable on outbreak units, see scenario #9</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Book a PCR test the day you are notified as well as day 5 and 10 after your initial swab at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a> <b>OR</b> at EH onsite drop in testing clinic.</li> <li>2. Self-monitor for symptoms</li> <li>3. If you develop symptoms, do not report to work, book a PCR test at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a> immediately and notify your manager. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If PCR positive, refer to scenario #5</li> <li>• If PCR negative, return to work when symptoms improve or refer to scenario #3 or #4.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	<p>Not applicable.</p>
<p>#9: HCW notified of a COVID-19 <b>outbreak</b> and has worked greater than 15 minutes in the outbreak department/unit in the prior 5 days.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Book a PCR test the day you are notified as well as day 5 and 10 after your initial swab at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a> <b>OR</b> at EH onsite drop in testing clinic.</li> <li>2. Further testing may be requested per IPC/Infectious Disease</li> <li>3. Self-monitor for symptoms</li> <li>4. If you develop symptoms, do not report to work, book a PCR test at <a href="#">GNB.ca</a> immediately and notify your manager. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If PCR positive, refer to scenario # 5</li> <li>• If PCR negative, return to work when symptoms improve or refer to scenario #3 or #4.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	<p>Not applicable.</p>
